## *Red Oak Community School District* Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors

#### VISITORS AND PRESENTATIONS

Kerry Hohbach, Project Coordinator for the Blue Zones Project gave an update to the Board of Directors on the work being done to secure the designation of Red Oak as a Blue Zones Community. Good news was shared which included the successes from ROHS students at the district speech contest, a successful showing of achievement by the wrestling team at the John J. Harris Invitational at Corning, a Chat Mobility donation, and \$10,802 from an IASB insurance dividend.

#### APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Director Drey moved with a second by Director Dilley to approve the agenda as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

#### **RED OAK EDUCATION ASSOCIATION**

John Gambs, Red Oak Education Association Spokesman and Board President Lee Fellers exchanged proposals for the Interest Based Bargaining Proposal for the 2012-2013 school year.

Director Drey moved with a second by Director Griffen to amend the consent agenda removing board policy 401.1 Equal Employment Opportunity. The following consent agenda items were approved:

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### INSTRUCTIONAL MODELS FOR STUDENT SCHEDULING

Red Oak High School Principal Jedd Sherman presented two concepts in scheduling for the 2012-2013 school year. With significant discussion and suggestions by the Directors, it was determined the opportunity should be given for students, parents, and teachers to comment before any final decision is made to complete the change. At the February 13 regular meeting, the Directors invite anyone who has a comment or question to attend the 6:00 p.m. meeting and express their concerns or questions.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### ACT SCORES IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Red Oak High School Principal Jedd Sherman and Instructor Deb Blomstedt reported on a pilot ACT preparation program that is being implemented at the high school. Discussion followed.

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNER PROGRAM

An increase in the number of students who qualify for the English Language Learner (ELL) Program has prompted the Directors to seek additional staff for the 2012-2013 school year. Director Dilley moved with a second by Director Hayes to approve the hiring of a half-time English Language Learner Instructor for the 2012-2013 school year. The motion carried unanimously.

## FINANCIAL REPORTS

School Business Manager Shirley Maxwell provided the standard monthly business reports while extending comments concerning several monitoring tools used to manage the \$18 million dollar budget for Red Oak.

## **BOARD POLICIES**

Upon the request of the Superintendent, the Board removed policy 403.6 Drug and Alcohol Testing Program for further study and consideration.

Director Drey moved with a second by Director Dilley to approve the first reading of board policies: 401.1 Equal Opportunity Employment; 403.1 Employee Physical Examinations; 403.2 Employee Injury on the Job; 403.3 Communicable Diseases-Employees; 403.4 Hazardous Chemical Disclosure; 403.5 Substance-Free Workplace; 404 Employee Conduct and Appearance. The motion carried unanimously.

# **ONE-TO-ONE COMPUTER PROGRAM**

Technology Director Bob Deter reported on the learning management system proposal for the computer one-to-one program called "Schoology". Director Hayes moved with a second by Director Drey to approve a contract with Schoology, a learning and course management system for the 2012-2013 school year at a total cost of \$5,600. The motion carried unanimously.

Director Dilley moved with a second by Director Drey to authorize the technology director to include the Washington Intermediate School Building in the Schoology proposal. The motion carried unanimously.
