1. Warning

3. Go to Buddy Room

- Complete a Think Sheet
- Make up class work
- Process with teacher(s)
- More than one visit may result attending weekly Behavior Workshop

4. Go to Office

- Complete a Think Sheet
- Student calls the parent(s)
- Assigned to the weekly Behavior Workshop
- May also have an after school detention or ISS (In-school suspension)
- Make up class work
- Process with teacher(s)
- Return to class

- Process with lunchroom supervisor/teacher

4. Go to Office

- Same as classroom expectations (Behavior Workshop & parent phone call)
- Must process with office adult and lunchroom supervisor/teacher

At Recess/On Playground

1. Warning

2. Go to Safe Seat on Wall

- Think!! On wall remainder of recess
- Complete Think Sheet <u>next</u> recess
- Process with recess supervisor/teacher

3. Go to Buddy Desk Outside of Office

- Complete Think Sheet and lose next day's recess
- Process with adults(s) (Mrs. Ehmke, Mrs. Black or Mrs. Burnison)

4. Go to Office

- Same as classroom expectations (Behavior Workshop & parent phone call)
- Lose multiple days of recess
- Must process with office adult and special's teacher(s)
- Return to class
