Roger Carlson presented the Steering Committee on Facilities recommendation to the school board in accordance with the timeline that was laid out during each of the steering committee meetings.

Supt. Messinger presented information on possible reduction of positions for the 2017-2018 school year. The information presented listed the position and the impact it would have on section size, section numbers, and offerings. This item will be on the next agenda for further discussion.

## Approval of the Promise of Iowa Campaign - by Superintendent Tom Messinger

Motion by Director Blackman, second by Director Bryce Johnson to approve the resolution that the Red Oak Community Board of Education pledges to join and support the efforts of "The Promise of Iowa" campaign to ensure that Iowa lawmakers continue to prioritize investments to improve the community schools that create opportunities for more than 480,000 public school Iowa students. Motion carried unanimously. This resolution states the district recognizes the potential of all students as future leaders, citizens, and caretakers. It states the importance of our schools to close achievement gaps. It also states the need that Iowa Legislators and Taxpayers must support greater investments in our public schools and that we must be willing to commit public resources to guarantee all of our students receive a well-rounded curriculum in safe and modern school facilities in each community.


