Our niece, Natalia Tolosa Grass is very interested in coming to Red oak and attend the High School for her Senior year, planning to start in August 2017.

We will be her guardians and she will be living with us the entire year. As a exchange student, coming from Colombia, she needs to apply for a F1 Visa, process that requires the school to accept her first and then fill out the form I-20 for the Homeland Department.

The form I-20 requires a SEVIS number (Student Exchange Visitor Information System) which is given to any accredited school in the Country by the SEVP (Student-Exchange Visitor Program) to receive foreign students.

To Our knowledge, The Red Oak School District has never applied for this in the past .. This involve some fees of about \$2000 and filling out some forms . As the School is accredited and the SEVIS number is assigned, the process of the F1 Visa for any foreign student in the future can be started, given the school new opportunities to enroll international students. Some examples of public schools in the area already accredited are the ones at the Districts of Waterloo, Gilbert, Ames, Iowa City and West DesMoines.

Natalia's parents are willing to pay these fees and also the ones required by the School to attend the Senior year, and also we are willing to guide the school on the accreditation and applying processes if necessary.

In Red Oak, all the international exchange students have come under a different type of program with a different type of visa (J1), living with a host family assigned by them, as most probably you are aware of.

We really appreciate your help in this matter having also in mind the accreditation of the school for another r way to enroll new students .

Dear Red Oak Community School District,


