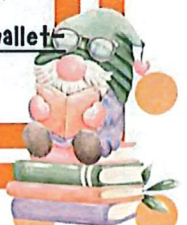

#### CALM & CONNECTED: LEARNING EMOTIONAL REGULATION FOR YOU & YOUR CHILD

This cafe will be virtual on May 13 from 4:30-6pm. It is for all adults/caregivers/parents that have a child in their life. To register call or text 712-355-2615 by May 12 at 4pm, or register online via the QR code.



Big Feelings, Calm Connections: Join us to build emotional balance for you and your child because regulation starts with relationship.



#### Objectives:

- Explore the foundations of emotional regulation and why it matters for caregivers and children.
- Strengthen your connection with your child by staying calm and supporting their understanding of emotions in everyday moments.
- Practice simple co-regulation techniques that promote self-awareness and emotional safety at home.
- Understand the importance of nurturing emotional regulation from birth.
- Learn age-appropriate strategies to help children name, manage, and express their emotions.

There will be a door prize drawing at the end of the café, plus a chance to be entered into a larger quarterly drawing for a family pass (such as a zoo membership)!
